


# ARCHITECTURE & ACCESSIBILITY

Find out about the architecture of the Cross River Rail stations and what makes them exemplars for accessible design.

A transformational project like Cross River Rail generates valuable data and unique resources that are potentially useful for a wide range of research topics.

Cross River Rail is a new 10.2km rail line that includes 5.9km of twin tunnels running under the Brisbane River and CBD; with four new underground stations at Boggo Road, Woolloongabba, Albert Street and Roma Street.




### How we designed uniquely Queensland underground stations
